



# Taase'ong Bingo

## A Haunting Time Bingo



Taase'ong means "A Haunting Time" and is a common way to say Halloween. Other ways to say this in Anishinaabe country include Taasewong or Tasewon. You will see this word written multiple ways but notice they are all similar!

**Instructions:** Fill out your bingo card from the word list on page 2. Sketch a visual of the word in the square, too. Notice that there are 16 squares but 18 words. You pick the ones you want and where they go. If you get a bingo, you get to yell bakinaage (I win) and pick out some ziinzibaakwadoons (candy)! Alternate calling and writing in English and Ojibwe.
